

Results of Housing Survey.

A total of 10 forms have been received back:

In 9 cases the household size was 2 and 1 not stated.

Housing needs raised:

Most respondents did not have or anticipate a housing need. However 2 said they had immediate needs and 1 anticipated a need in approximately 3 years.

Comment made were:

‘Need more housing now for downsizing and also low cost starter homes’

‘Need to downsize but not able due to planning restrictions.’

‘Need for affordable 3 bedroom housing.’

Other comments regarding housing /planning:

‘No change to village planning criteria’

‘A clear strategy for local planning to maintain the character of Playden. Unacceptable local planning applications.’

‘A local plan which would not consider the area unsustainable when it isn’t’

Other local problems and concerns raised:

Waiting times for NHS services - GPs, Dentists and hospitals.

No supermarket open on a Sunday.

Rye doesn’t cater for young people or families.

Overgrown public footpaths (2).

Potholes

Better broadband.

A by-pass for Rye and Winchelsea, Icklesham.

Vehicles driving into verges and blocking drainage ditch.

Litter and litter collection

Speeding traffic and traffic police.
