| | KG had driven down Houghton Green Lane and had made a note of the potholes. There had been some English and Union Jack flags attached to lamp posts in some areas of East Sussex and red crosses painted on some mini roundabouts and crossings. When council workers had gone out to repaint these some workers had been threatened and verbally abused and had subsequently been withdrawn due to this intimidation. Devolution: Work is continuing on the plans and is due for submission to the government on 26th September 2025. Brighton and Hove city council are drawing up with a separate plan which is due to be released on 12th September 2025, No consultation has been undertaken with East or West Sussex. Long term devolution should have cost savings but only to back office costs not front line. These savings are based on areas of approx. 500,000 people, if smaller cost savings will be less. Work has started on planning next year's budget. There are escalating costs in providing elderly and children care packages such as taxis to school (£28 million a year). | |
